Jumpstart Reading - Phonemic Awareness

Have fun learning to read this summer. Our program is based on the [Orton-Gillingham](#) method of reading instruction and is administered by a certified Speech Pathologist trained in the program. The Orton-Gillingham methodology utilizes phonetics and emphasizes visual, auditory and kinesthetic learning styles. Instruction begins by focusing on the structure of language and gradually moves towards reading. The program provides students with immediate feedback and a predictable sequence that integrates reading, writing, and spelling.
